

We provide technical assistance to managing authorities, intermediate bodies and beneficiaries of all ERDF and ESF Operational Programmes in their management and financial control work, and in particular in carrying out administrative and on-the-spot verification reports..

The knowledge of the operations object of verification is indispensable to carry out a work with guarantees, for that reason we have specialists in different areas of financing: public subsidies, research projects, public works, projects of sustainable urban development, educational projects and social projects, among others.

We provide technical assistance to various Spanish Ministries, such as the Ministry of Economy and Finance, the Ministry of the Environment and Rural and Marine Affairs, as well as autonomous bodies such as the Carlos III Health Institute and the National Institute of Agricultural and Food Research and Technology (INIA).





Our clients also include a large number of Town Councils, Provincial Councils and Public Law Companies, as well as numerous companies benefiting from public subsidies. Since 2009, ARCA has been providing technical assistance to the Carlos III Health Institute for the management and subsequent verification of more than 300 annual grants subsidised by the ERDF in the different operational programmes in which it participates. It also provides technical assistance in the management and control of the EDUSI for the Logroño City Council. We would also like to highlight the technical assistance provided to intermediate bodies of the European Social Fund such as the Fundación Once, the Fundación Secretariado Gitano or FSC Inserta.

ARCA is a success guarantee for the participation in European tenders, not only because it has a highly specialized team working on the management of European programmes but also due to its permanent presence and representation in Brussels. This allows us to carry out the follow-up tasks on the releasing of the next calls for proposals by the European Commission (EC) and the preparation of proposal applications for them, with our training and information being constantly updated through the attendance to the different networking, information and consultation events periodically organized both by the EC (about their own programmes, dealing with a large number of topics and always focused on the better development of the EU policies), and by the other European agencies and institutions (such as the Committee of the Regions or the European Parliament).





The Public Administrations outsource certain activities in which ARCA has extensive experience in the implementation of procedures in various areas such as public assets and assistance in the management of public procurement procedures.

In the area of PUBLIC HERITAGE that includes both the management of purchase and sale as well as the rental of premises and housing, the experience developed in this sector has generated the solid creation of a perfectly organized infrastructure, which allows not only administrative but also legal management in these areas. ARCA has developed its own management methodology for land regularisation, heritage privatisation processes and technical assistance to Public Administrations.



ARCA has extensive experience acting as a **BUREAU OF PROCUREMENT** for public and private institutions that are contracting authorities. ARCA acts as an independent company to evaluate bids, and decide, on the basis of the criteria established in the specifications (previously revised), which is the most advantageous offer.

- For the Housing Institute of Madrid (IVIMA) files have been analyzed, drawn, awarded and delivered around 800 homes throughout the Community of Madrid, treated around 15,000 files of property owned by IVIMA, both to offer them for sale, as to resolve different types of legal and contractual situations.
- We also highlight the contract with the Directorate General of Housing and Rehabilitation of the Community of Madrid, which consists of the management of the Office of Rehabilitation of Buildings of Madrid South - ORE 06- (Integrated Rehabilitation). This office provided information, advice and processed more than 700 applications for aid from the Community of Madrid for the refurbishment of buildings, as well as 340 applications for aid for the installation of lifts.
- For the Ministry of Housing, (Subdirectorate General of Aid), we implemented the contract for the Basic Income of Emancipation of Youth, which covers the entire national territory, and involved managing the payment of more than 130,000 beneficiaries every month.
- In the Guadiana Hydrographic Confederation (Badajoz), technical assistance was provided consisting of technical and legal work in the processing of the agency's contracting dossiers.
- For the City Council of Logroño we executed a service contract for information and advice on matters pertaining to the Directorate General of Heritage and legal assistance to technical services in housing at the national level: management of the Rental Exchange Programme, information for those affected by mortgage foreclosures, claims for land clauses, control and processing of ITE minutes, as well as administrative support to the units of Economic Promotion and Urban Development and Environment.
- We offer the service of support to different managements of the General Secretary of the Institute of Health Carlos III. These are support procedures for the staff that provide their services in the Public Contracting Area attached to the aforementioned Secretariat.
